This is a summary of the annual report of the Construction and General Building Laborers Local Union 79 Legal Services Plan, EIN 13-3882419, Plan No. 501, legal plan, for period January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Construction and General Building Laborers Local Union 79 has committed itself to pay certain claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Basic Financial Statement

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$0 as of December 31, 2024, compared to \$0 as of January 1, 2024. During the plan year, the plan had total income of \$1,411,875, including other income of \$1,411,875.

Plan expenses were \$1,411,875. These expenses included \$11,088 in administrative expenses, and \$1,400,787 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries.
